



# Alabama Legislative Internship

## 2019 Regular Session

**February 25 – June 17, 2019**

### Unpaid Internship for College Credit

#### **Purpose:**

The program was established to include student interns in the state legislature by allowing them to observe and participate in the legislative process of state government.

#### **Internship Requirements:**

- Each intern must be a Junior or higher in college or in graduate school.
- Interns must either be Alabama residents or be attending a college or university in Alabama.

#### **Term:**

The term will coincide with the 2019 Regular Session. These are temporary positions for college credit for 30 hours per week (Monday – Thursday, 8:00 – 4:30) located in the State House in Montgomery, Alabama.

#### **Application and Selection Process:**
