
Motor Vehicle Updates





Act 2018-190 (SB214)

- Vehicle owner Opts In or Out to disclose certain personal info to sponsoring organization at the time of initial registration
 - Owner name
 - Owner address
 - Owner email address, if available
- DOR provides information to sponsoring organization annually, upon request
- Sponsoring organization prohibited from reselling info
- Includes: distinctive, collegiate and plates approved by LOC
- Opt In/Out field to be included in registration record
 - Programing will be needed by licensing official vendors
- Opt-in/out language added on POD registration receipt affidavit
- Effective: January 1, 2019






House Joint Resolution 14

- Research and draft recommendations to combat curbstoning and abandoned vehicle fraud
- · Task force includes:
 - DOR (chair)
 - AIADA
 - ADAA
 - Bankers Association
 - Credit Union Association
 - AATA
 - AG's Office of Consumer Interest
 - Consumer representative appointed by house
 - MV industry representative appointed by senate
- Recommendations submitted to legislature by February 2019



Print on Demand

- · 31 counties currently on POD
- Memo 2017-015 POD specifications
 - Roll decals not available January 2019 (2020 decals will be POD)
- Law Enforcement memo sent Dec. 2017 and reminder memo sent July 27, 2018
 - · Accept POD or roll decals
 - Registrant present registration tangible or electronic format
- MVD will begin updating plate designs for single decal pocket in 2019 as plates redesign








Print on Demand

- When can we start POD?
 - Email from Sherry Helms November 2017
 - · Is your printer good for POD?
 - · Yes, then do you have all paper trays need?
 - · 2 for POD paper and 1 plain paper from MVD perspective
 - · Talk to vendor to determine date
 - · Send Sherry/Jonathan an email about planned start date
 - · Give two week notice so material can be sent
 - We place first POD order and send you an invoice containing control numbers to be assigned to the POD material as used
 - Reorders your staff places in AIMS (decals: POD Green 2019)




Print on Demand


- Include DOR assigned control number in decal field on registration receipt and registration record
- Control number same as current roll decal numbers (8 characters)
 - · 2 digit county code and 6 digit sequential number
 - · Assigned by DOR when ordered
- County system should produce audit report with:
 - · Control numbers
 - · Time period
 - · Sortable (clerkID, date, etc.)



Print on Demand

- MLI Reinstatement fees (32-7A-12):
- Licensing officials retain 10%
 - 50% to county general fund
 - 50% Special registration/titling technology fund
- Peace officers annuity fund 15%
- Remainder to fund MLI program and state general fund






- Temporary Tags
 - Order/Receive Inventory in AIMS
 - If get error message and can't issue tempscheck AIMS for outstanding order to receive
 - Temporary Tag Report (Discovery)






ML.I

- Issue with mailing Notices of Suspension
 - · Some registrants did not receive notices in a timely manner
 - · Some registrants received duplicate notices
- All potentially affected records were changed to deferred suspension (DS) status so that registrants receive proper notice before registration was suspended
- Notice of Suspension mailings resumed September 12th
 - DS status will change to S1 or S2 once Notice of Suspension is mailed







Alabama Title System

- Alert designated agents when applications have not been submitted or documents have not been received.
- Allow designated agents to put their own applications on hold for 30 days.
- Allow resub letters to be reprinted.
- Update title webservice to include all data fields.
- Allow vehicle owners to apply for replacement applications online.
- Turn off ETAPS to new applications
